



MINISTRY OF THE WORD

THE FIRST READING COMES FROM THE ACTS OF THE APOSTLES, CHAPTER 10 BEGINNING AT VERSE 34

Then Peter began to speak to them: 'I truly understand that God shows no partiality, but in every nation anyone who fears him and does what is right is acceptable to him. You know the message he sent to the people of Israel, preaching peace by Jesus Christ—he is Lord of all. That message spread throughout Judea, beginning in Galilee after the baptism that John announced: how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power; how he went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with him. We are witnesses to all that he did both in Judea and in Jerusalem. They put him to death by hanging him on a tree; but God raised him on the third day and allowed him to appear, not to all the people but to us who were chosen by God as witnesses, and who ate and drank with him after he rose from the dead. He commanded us to preach to the people and to testify that he is the one ordained by God as judge of the living and the dead. All the prophets testify about him that everyone who believes in him receives forgiveness of sins through his name.'

Hear the Holy Gospel according to Matthew Chapter 28, beginning at verse 1

Glory to you Lord Jesus Christ

After the sabbath, as the first day of the week was dawning, Mary Magdalene and the other Mary went to see the tomb. And suddenly there was a great earthquake; for an angel of the Lord, descending from heaven, came and rolled back the stone and sat on it. His appearance was like lightning, and his clothing white as snow. For fear of him the guards shook and became like dead men. SERMON

RENEWAL OF BAPTISM VOWS

Will you persevere in resisting evil, and, whenever you fail, repent and return to God?

I will, with God's help.

Will you proclaim by word and example the good news of God in Christ? I will, with God's help.

Will you seek to serve Christ by loving your neighbour as yourself? I will with God's help.

Will you work and pray for justice and peace among all people, and respect the dignity of every human being?

I will with God's help.

May Almighty God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has given us new birth by water and the Holy Spirit, and bestowed upon us the forgiveness of sins, keep us in eternal life by his grace, in Christ Jesus our Lord. **Amen.**

Creator Spirit, rekindle in us your gifts of grace, renew our life in Christ and bring to completion all that your calling has begun.

God of Mercy, God of Mystery, you have given us grace and courage to pray with one heart and one voice; and promised to hear the prayers of two or three who gather in your name;

fulfill now, we pray, the prayers and longings of your people as may be best for us and for your holy realm.
